NATIONAL COMMITTEE PRESIDENT SULTAN YILMAZ'S MESSAGE

Hello to all,

I am one of those who believe that non-formal education is as important as formal education for raising the new generation. In personal development; I think that activities with more philosophies are effective than academic education, for example, established upbringing and parental approaches. Isn't it possible for young people to prepare for life and gain a universal perspective by living and learning?

From this point of view, I gave my heart to the International Award for Young People Programme, which I met in 2003.

The International Award for Young People Programme was implemented in Turkey between 1994 and 1995 with several institutions. In 2001, the Turkish Human Resources Education and Health Foundation (TİKAV) introduced the programme to its scholarship students.

In May 2002; The Ministry of National Education has officially approved the implementation of the Award Programme in high school equivalent schools in 7 pilot provinces including Ankara, Aydın, Bursa, Elazığ, Eskişehir, Gaziantep and Kayseri. At this stage, TİKAV has provided support like the Open Award Centre. Auditing and certification was carried out by the International Office.

On September 17, 2003, the “Youth Award Association”, whose sole purpose is the Award Programme, was established by the educators who implemented the 'International Award for Young People Programme' within their own bodies and by representatives of TİKAV and the Turkish-British Friendship Association, and the programme started to be carried out by the association. The association was recognized as the Independent Award Centre (IAC) in October 2003.

NATIONAL COMMITTEE PRESIDENT SULTAN YILMAZ'S MESSAGE

In 2012, with the “One Name, One Programme” decision taken at the Malta Forum meetings, it was decided to represent TİKAV under the name “DoEIA-Türkiye” in Turkey, based on the consensus that “a youth NGO or organization can be included” in our discussions with international office officials and the License Agreement was signed in 2013.

From 1 June 2013 to July 2020, the Programme is implemented in Turkey under the name “The Duke of Edinburgh's International Award-Türkiye” under the representation of The Turkish Human Resources Education and Health Foundation (TİKAV). In September 2013, the Youth Award Association ceased to operate; TİKAV carried out the Programme as a National Authority.

In July 2020, the name used in Turkey was changed and the name “The International Award for Young People – Türkiye” was registered on the international platform and TİKAV continues to spread, implement and certify the program as a National Authority.

As someone who has served as a manager in all its structures since 2003; we worked together with the members of the TİKAV Management and IAYP-TR National Committee to develop this programme, which I believe is very fruitful. While we are pleased with the progress, there is more work to be done, too many young people to reach.

NATIONAL COMMITTEE PRESIDENT SULTAN YILMAZ'S MESSAGE

Our goal should be to reach at least 60% of all young people between the ages of 14 and 24; in order to contribute to the personal development of all young people who can or cannot go to school, who are disabled, who work on the street, whose social/economic conditions are suitable or inappropriate. The bar for success that I set for myself was "to reach young people living on the street." So far, we have not been able to get to the point I want. However, I am sure that this goal will be achieved in the near future.

Of course, more volunteers are needed to reach more young people. Well; more Award Leaders, more Supervisors, more Assessors. Because without them, there is no application. But it is very important that the managers of private or public institutions also support the Award Programme. I think it is necessary for us to work together "to reach more participants and volunteers without compromising the quality of the programme" and we look forward to your support.

Implementation of the International Award for Young People Programme; requires a certain staff, material and expenditure. The main sponsor of the programme, AKFEN Holding Incorporate Company Management, especially the Chairman of the Board of Directors, Mr. Hamdi AKIN, provided full support. As IAYP-TR Management, we are grateful. So what; more financial resources are needed to reach more participants, especially to work with disadvantaged youth. I hope that you who believe in the programme can also contribute to fundraising.

Since the International Award for Young People Programme started to be implemented in Turkey; I would like to express my gratitude to everyone who opened their hearts, touched, and contributed to the programme. Bless their hearts and efforts.

ABOUT THE AWARD

International Award for Young People - Türkiye; It is an international program that supports out-of-school education that encourages young people between the ages of 14 and 24 to set goals, achieve their goals, celebrate their achievements and make a difference in society.

The Award has inspired millions of young people to change their lives since 1956. participants design their Award Programme, set their goals and enroll their progress. The Award plays an important role in the lives of young people outside of school, enabling them to be active, creating emphasis on their **Skill**, **Physical Recreation** and **Service**, and experience **Adventurous Journey**. The Award Programme enables young people to be recognized worldwide and gain a special international experience.

The Award Programme also helps young people to inspire individuals and communities and to improve themselves. Young people participating in the Award Programme learn to be self-confident and solution-oriented. They develop communication, problem solving and leadership skills. In this way, it affects the society in areas such as health, educational attainment, employment.

Thanks to the International Award for Young People, young people; they desire to create a meaningful change not only for themselves but also for their environment, by recognizing their goals and passions.



THE HISTORY OF THE AWARD



1956

The Award was founded in 1956 by The Duke of Edinburgh Prince Philip and started being delivered as 'The Duke of Edinburgh's International Award'.

1995

The Award was introduced to Turkey in 1995; it was delivered by the Turkish- English Friendship Association and schools.

2001

The Ministry of Education officially approved the delivery of the Award in high schools across 7 pilot cities and to TIKAV scholars. Within this time, the validation and certification of the delivery of the Award was under the responsibility of the International Award Foundation.



2013

Between the dates of the 1st of June 2013 and 9th of July 2020, the Award delivered under the name of The Duke of Edinburgh's International Award – Türkiye.

2020

Since the 9th of July, 2020, the Award has started to be delivered with the name of The International Award For Young People - Türkiye (IAYP-TR), which is represented by TİKAV.



MISSION, VISION AND GOALS

Our Vision To increase the individual and societal value of young people that are living in our country through providing Access for them to participate and complete The Award.



Our Mission To provide the right conditions for delivering The Award, to promote The Award in a qualified manner within the framework of the standards and to preserve the quality of The Award nationwide.

Our Goal is to make The Award available to all 14-24 year olds in Turkey.

Turkey's Goal for 2022 is to increase the number of participants to 3500.

To increase the Award completion rate in line with the new entrants.

GUIDING PRINCIPLES

Individual Participants design their own Programme, which can be tailored to suit their personal circumstances, choices and local provision. They start at whichever level suits them best and they can take as long as they wish (within the age limit) to achieve their Award.

Non- Competitive Doing their Award is a personal challenge and not a competition against others. Every Participant's programme is tailor-made to reflect their individual starting point, abilities and interests.

Achievable An Award is achievable by any individual who chooses to take up the challenge, regardless of ability, gender, background or location, with the right guidance and inspiration.

Voluntary Whilst the Award may be offered within school, college, work time, custody or extra-curricular activity, individuals choose to do a programme and must commit some of their free time to undertake their activities.

Development Participating in their Award Programme fosters personal and social development. Individuals gain valuable experiences and life skills, grow in confidence and become more aware of their environment and community transforming them into responsible young adults.

GUIDING PRINCIPLES

Balanced

The Award provides a balanced framework to develop the individual's mind, body and community spirit by engaging them in range of activities in up to five different challenges.

Progressive

At each level of engagement, the Award demands progressively more time, commitment and responsibility from the Participant.

Inspirational

The Award inspires individuals to exceed their expectations. They are encouraged to set their own challenges and goals before starting an activity, aim for these goals and by showing improvement will achieve an Award.

Persistence

The Award requires and cannot be completed with a short burst of enthusiasm. Participants are encouraged to continue with activities and to maintain their interest beyond their programme requirements.

Enjoyable

Participants and Award Leaders should find the Award enjoyable, fulfilling and rewarding.



OUR STRATEGY

3 Year Strategy

Access

Increasing the number of new Award entrants, particularly those from at risk or marginalised communities.

Reach

Increasing the number of Award Centres and deliverers by improving the social infrastructure of the Award.

Impact

Increasing Award completion rates by assisting, supporting and training providers- volunteers and Leaders- to enable more young people to achieve their Award.

AWARD LEVELS

Bronze

The Bronze Category is for young people **older than 14 years old**. In the Bronze Category, Award Participants complete the Physical Recreation, Skills, Service and Adventurous Journey sections of the Award. In the first 3 sections, they take part in 3 different activities based on the goals they want to achieve. In this category, the participants have to take part in one activity for a minimum of **26 weeks**. In this category, the A&J lasts **2 days and 1 night**. The Bronze Category is completed in **26 weeks**.



Silver

The Silver Category is for young people **older than 15 years old**. In the Silver Category, Award Participants complete the Physical Recreation, Skills, Service and Adventurous Journey sections of the Award. In the first 3 sections, they take part in 3 different activities based on the goals they want to achieve. In this category, the participants have to take part in one activity for a minimum of **26 weeks**. In this category, the A&J lasts **3 days and 2 nights**. If the participants is a Bronze Award Holder, the other sections must be carried out for at least **26 weeks**. If the participant has directly starts with Silver, then one of the activities must be carried out for **52 weeks**. In conclusion, for Bronze Award Holders this category is completed in **26 weeks**, for new entrants it is completed in **52 weeks**.

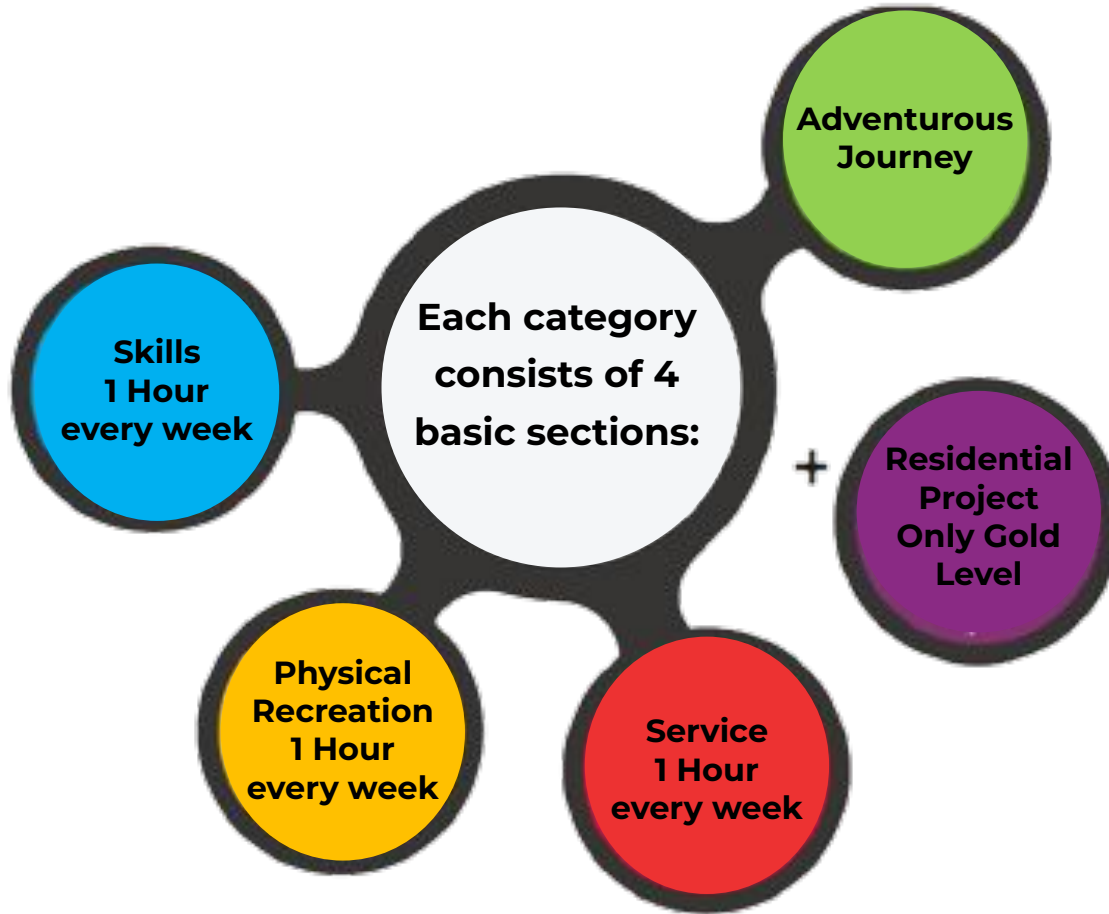


Gold

The Gold Category is for young people **older than 16 years old**. In the Gold Category, Award Participants does not only complete the Physical Recreation, Skills, Service and A&J sections of the Award, but they also take part in a Residential Project. The activities for the first three sections last **52 weeks**; if the participants is starting the Gold Award from scratch, then they must carry out one more activities out of the first three sections for another **6 months**. In this category the A&J lasts **4 days and 3 nights**. Unique to this category, The Residential Project must last at least **5 days and 4 nights**. In this situation Silver Award Holders complete the Gold Category in **52 weeks**, new entrants complete it in at least **78 weeks**.

Looking back, it took me about a year and a half to complete the Silver category and it wasn't easy at all. We could neither go on the Adventurous Journey we wanted, nor could we finish the programme on the date we set. The pandemic had really made it very difficult, but upon reflection, I realized that this situation gave us a lot more skills than it would have normally been. I would like to focus on the Virtual Adventurous Journey, where it took the final stage of my Award Journey.

Maybe we haven't been able to fully implement the survival, navigation or route-setting skills we'll learn. But we've gained the much more important problem-solving and adaptation skills. I was shocked like everyone else when I heard that I could do the Adventurous Journey virtually. Because I didn't know what to expect. I had to step out of my comfort zone. However, under the leadership of our Supervisor, we tried to follow every step in a meaningful way, as a group of 6 people and understanding the importance of cooperation. Providing the task division as a team has been our strongest foundation while completing our online work.

Throughout the process, we took care to fill in each report down to the smallest detail, without compromising our ethical values. In addition, the virtual expedition and the system we are trying to adapt showed us the importance of correctly identifying the source of our problems. This ability actually formed the basis of our problem-solving ability, as accurately identifying the problems we encountered was a large part of solving them. However, it was not always easy to detect problems.

Sometimes, the conditions we were in were challenging and we could not see our way due to stress. In such cases, we learned crisis management with group work and planning, and in this way, we solved the problems as unsolvable by breaking them into small pieces.

Although we do not realize it directly, the most important hallmark of the Award is an international programme. Regardless of religion, language, race, gender or country, every young person goes through the same stages with the Award and develops themselves and becomes a citizen of the world. The work we have completed has not only transformed us into a full-fledged citizen of the world, but also enabled us to discover our own talents and interests. In addition, if we consider the process, our self-evaluations have gained important experiences for our future lives.

I can say that the Award has been the key to the doors of learning that will open for us throughout life as well as improving ourselves right now.
