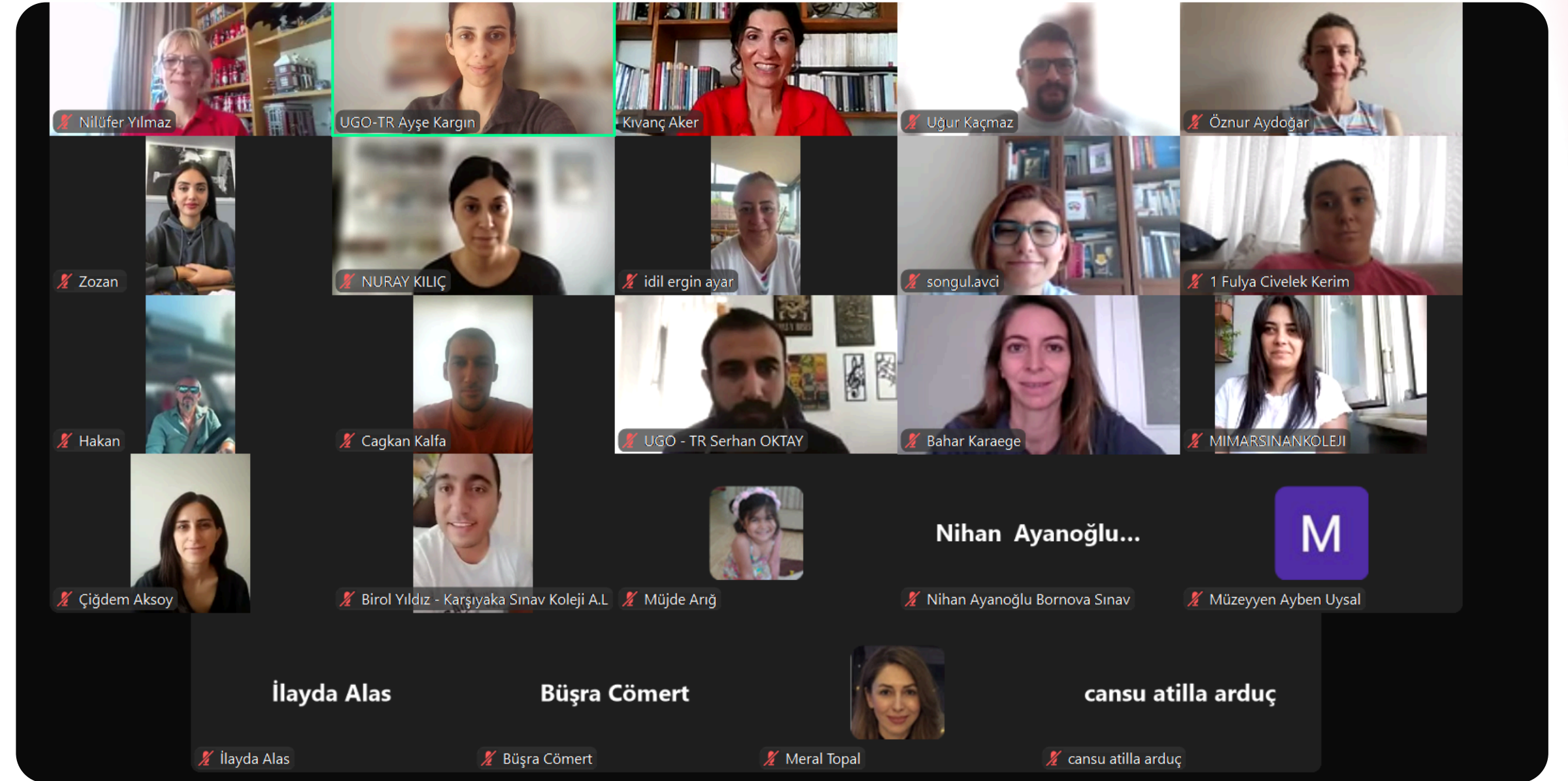

At the beginning of the journey, I was actually quite scared. I thought, how can we walk so many kilometers with such a heavy load on our backs? In fact, when we first started walking, one of our friends fell over due to the weight, and we laughed a lot about it. I especially struggled a lot when we started walking because there were no trees at the starting point. As a result, the sun was beating down on us. But I guess I got used to it as we walked. At our first break, I literally felt a sense of peace. This feeling of tranquility was dominant during each subsequent break as well. I was particularly happy during our lunch break because we had managed to move forward without going off track. By the time we were nearing the campsite, I was about to collapse from exhaustion. Before helping to set up the tents, I sat down to catch my breath, and then we set up the tent. Cooking the meals became a separate source of tension for us because everyone was very tired and hungry, so no one had any patience left for anyone else. But once everyone was full, they became as soft as cotton. When I crawled into my sleeping bag, I felt every cell in my body.

This journey really made me feel alive, so no matter how hard I try, I can't fully describe what a beautiful experience it was. I woke up around six-thirty in the morning. Waking up to the sound of birds outside and the gentle patter of raindrops on the tent was a completely different feeling. We got up, had our tea, ate our breakfast, and quickly packed up. I think the second day was even more beautiful than the first because our backpacks were a bit lighter and the weather was cool. The only challenge we faced on the second day was the mud and the streams we jumped over. The mud formed huge platforms under our shoes, making it difficult to walk, but honestly, jumping over the streams was incredibly fun, so I was happy that new streams kept appearing. By the time we reached the end of the journey, I had a friend with me, and we both started running. However, on the way back, I felt a bittersweet sensation inside me because it was an unforgettable journey.

## SAFETY TIPS FOR CAMP SET

For the cooking area, a sturdy and flat surface where the stove will not tip over is ideal and should be at least two meters away from flammable materials and all camping gear.

Take into account the weather conditions and wind direction.

Never pack up the camp stove while there is fuel in the burner (fuel tank). When packing up the camp stove, always place the burner (fuel tank) inside the kettle in a sealed bag.



Store fuel canisters in a ventilated and safe area, away from direct sunlight or heat.

Never use the stove indoors or inside the tent. Always choose an outdoor area that is well-ventilated and away from obvious risks.

Never leave a lit stove unattended.

Have a safe place nearby to set down hot pots.



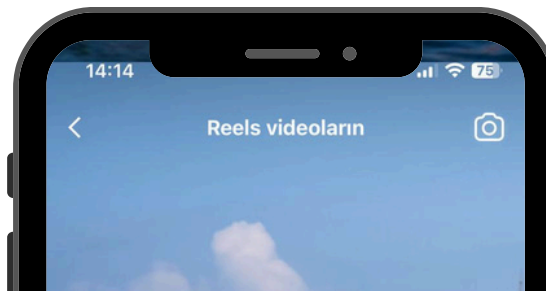
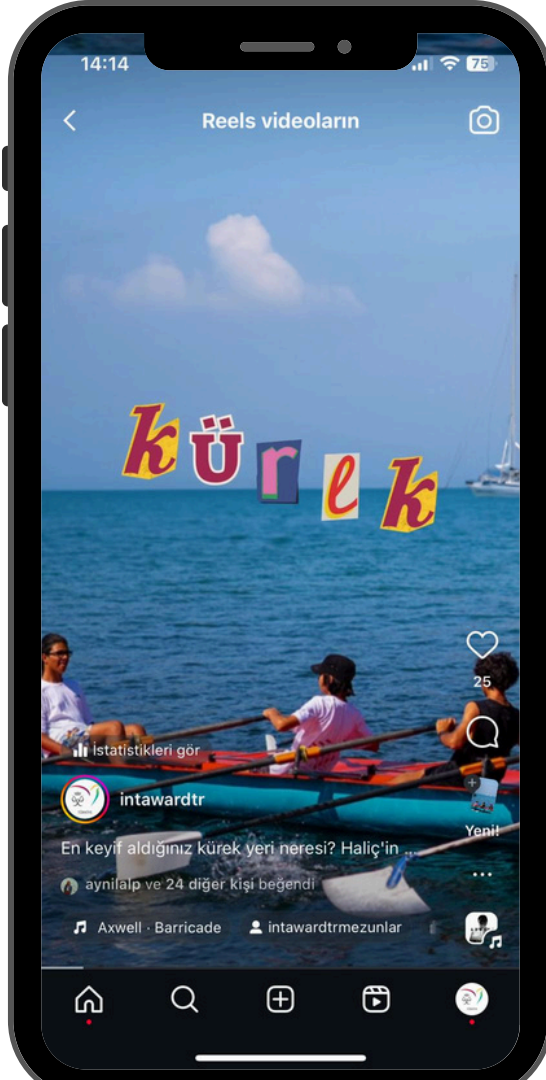
If you need to add fuel to your stove or your fuel runs out while using it, follow these steps to safely refuel:

Ensure the fire is extinguished. Only take the burner (fuel tank) when it is cool enough to handle. Never refuel if the fuel tank is too hot to touch.

Be sure of how to use the stove and the associated hazards. For example, fuel in canisters is extremely flammable and should be handled with care.

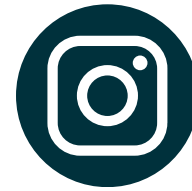
Clearly inform others that the stoves are lit/hot.

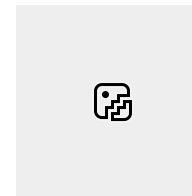
